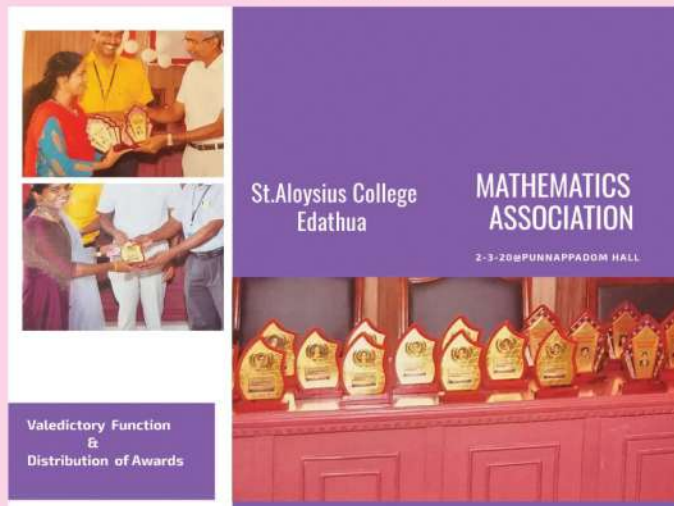

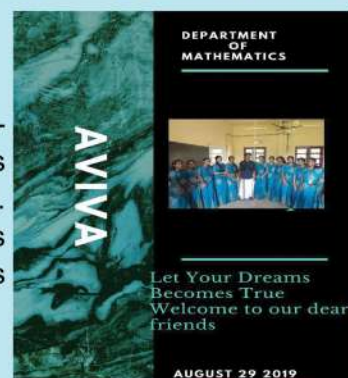
DEGREE BATCH
