The Department of Mathematics was established in 1980 with the introduction of BSc programme in Mathematics. The department is celebrating its Ruby Jubilee year from October 2019 to September 2020 with a variety of programmes including lecture series, inter-collegiate competitions and extension programmes. On this occasion here is a brief history of the department. With the introduction of BSc programme

in 1980 we were elevated to the status of an independent department. The first Mathematics faculty of St. Aloysius college Sri. K.I. Abdul Latif was appointed the head of the department. Smt. Rosamma Thomas



who is also an alumna joined the college in 1974. Smt. Aniamma Peter and Smt. Rosamma Luke joined the department in 1980. In 1981, Smt. Valsamma Mathew, Sri.K.U Zacharia and Sri.Joy Joseph joined the department. In 1995 the department was upgraded to a post graduate department. In the same year Smt. Ancy Peter joined the department. In 1996 Smt. KochuThressiamma Joseph, alumna and Dr. Indulal G. joined. Later Dr. Mary George (2008), Sri. Jogy Joseph (2009), Smt. Deena C Scaria (2012), Sri. Jijo Joy (2012) and Dr. Jubin Antony (2012) joined the department. Smt. KochuThressiamma Joseph is the present Head of the Department.
